



1:15-22 – Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation, “so you might know him better.”
Hope. Riches. Power.

2:18 – Bold access to the Father, “by one Spirit.”

2:22 – You are being “built together” to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.

3:14-21 – He may strengthen you with power through his Spirit.

4:1-3 – Live a life “worthy”, keep the unity of the Spirit.

4:30 – Do not grieve the Holy Spirit with whom you were sealed.

5:18 – Be continually being filled with the Holy Spirit.
Express the result through Praise.

6:10 – Be strong in the Lord AND Be strong in his mighty power.

6:17,18 – Take...the sword of the Spirit which is the word of God
“Rhema theou”

6:18 – Pray in the Spirit
On all occasions
With all kinds of prayers and requests
Be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints

Five reasons we need to be filled with and keep full of the Holy Spirit:

1. Because Jesus promises the Helper Comforter as **God come beside you to complete God’s purpose for you by His power in you.**
2. Because Jesus commands His disciples to receive the promise that **He might replicate His life in each of us** by this means.
3. Because the fullness of the Holy Spirit **overflows the empty of our spiritual capacities and expels the unworthy of the world’s spirit.**
4. Because the power of the Holy Spirit births a passion to **reach the unsaved**, and a compassion which can **love people to life.**
5. Because spiritual language begets ceaseless praise and prayer that **exalts Christ, breaks evil bonds and builds up believers.**

1:3 – Christ “has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every SPIRITUAL blessing in Christ.”
Spiritual = pneumatikos.

1:13 – Having believed you were marked in him with a “seal” the promised Holy Spirit,
A “deposit” guaranteeing what is to come.
